## Laptop Setup

Cerner Off Campus Access:

1. Make sure you have either Safari or Internet Explorer installed/updated to the latest version on your laptop. Cerner Off Campus Access does not work well with other web browsers.
2. Go to <http://www.citrix.com/downloads.html>
3. Select Citrix Receiver.
  - a. It should automatically provide the correct install for your device.
  - b. If this does not work, scroll through the Receiver options and select the specific Receiver for your device.
4. Download the Receiver and install it.
5. Go to <https://receiver.health.unm.edu> to access Cerner Off Campus and login.

VPN Installation:

The VPN service is intended to connect your computer to the HSC network from off-site. This provides security for data in motion between your computer and the HSC network while also making available resources that are only accessible from on the hospital campus.

1. Complete the UNM Health System Virtual Private Network (VPN) Access Authorization for Remote Network Access class on Learning Central.
2. Print your certificate.
  - a. After completing the class, go to History, click on the class name and Print Certificate.
  - b. This will generate a PDF file that you can save.
3. Email your certificate to [NSparlin@salud.unm.edu](mailto:NSparlin@salud.unm.edu) who will confirm your access.
4. Once you have access, go to <http://hslic.unm.edu/usersupport/support/software-downloads.html>
5. Select VPN Access & Instructions.
  - a. Apple Users: Follow the directions on the website to temporarily disable the Gatekeeper feature before installing VPN.
6. Click on the Cisco AnyConnect Link for Windows or Mac and change your Group to hsc-unm.
7. Log in using your HSC NetID and password and follow the instructions.
  - a. Apple Users: Follow the directions on the website to re-enable the Gatekeeper feature.
